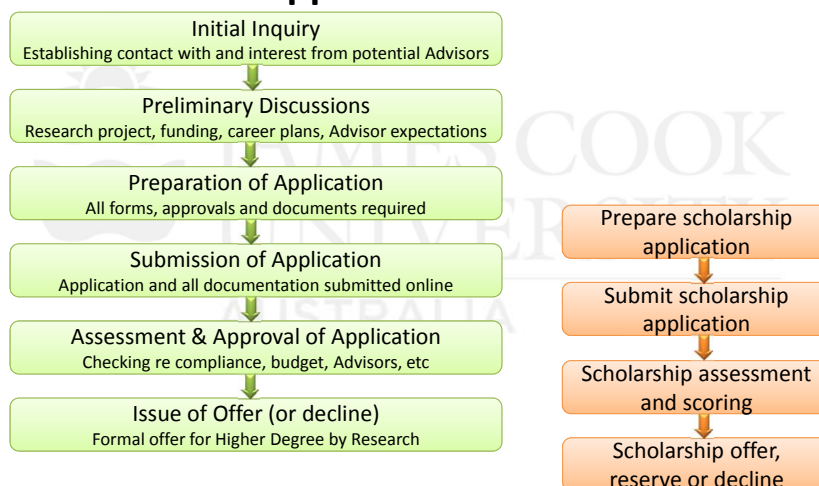




HDR Candidature & Scholarship Application Process

Why is this necessary?

- Each HDR application is unique and must be assessed accordingly
- Ethically and legally, JCU must ensure that a student being admitted to a research degree has a reasonable chance of completing it successfully within the time available
 i.e. project can be funded, candidate has the necessary skills, the Advisors will be foreseeably available for the duration of the degree, they will have access to the equipment and support needed, etc.
- There can be severe consequences for an International government-sponsored candidates who do not complete/complete in time
- The UN and Autonomous Sanctions are federal law hence the University must ensure compliance
- The cost of non-completion of a candidate to the University can be over \$300,000 per candidate
